WHEREAS, there is now pending before the Oregon legislature House Bill No. 1281 which would establish maximum hours for city firemen at 56 hours per week, and


WHEREAS, the reduction of working hours of firemen would greatly increase the necessary expenditure for the support of the Fire Department of the City of Albany and the increased expenditure would make it impossible to finance within the present fiscal ability of the city, and

WHEREAS, the regulation of working hours of city firemen is properly a matter that should be left to the legislative powers of the municipalities in the cities of Oregon, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City of Albany go on record as opposing House Bill No. 1281 which regulates the maximum number of hours for city firemen at 56 hours per week. Be it further

RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the legislators from Linn County, Oregon.
