

ADOPTION OF ENGINEER'S REPORTS, AUTHORIZATION TO SECURE EASEMENTS, TO OBTAIN BIDS, AND TO ISSUE WARRANTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OR IMPROVEMENT OF CLEVELAND STREET FROM SANTIAM ROAD NORTH TO RAILROAD; THURSTON STREET FROM 13th AVENUE TO QUEEN AVENUE; JEFFERSON STREET FROM 13th TO QUEEN AVENUE; 15th AVENUE FROM PARK TERRACE TO BROADWAY STREET; SHERMAN STREET FROM EIGHTH AVENUE TO NINTH AVENUE; ELM STREET FROM QUEEN AVENUE TO 21ST AVENUE; SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION HILL STREET, QUEEN AVE. TO 28th AVENUE, 24th AVENUE, HILL STREET TO MAIN STREET AND CONSTRUCTION OF SOUTH RESIDENTIAL SANITARY SEWER LATERAL EXT. NO. 10.

BE IT RESOLVED, the reports of the City Engineer filed with the City Recorder on the 8th day of April, 1963, concerning the construction or improvement of Cleveland Street from Santiam Road North to Railroad; Thurston Street from 13th Avenue to Queen Avenue; Jefferson Street from 13th to Queen Avenue; 15th Avenue from Park Terrace to Broadway Street; Sherman Street from Eighth Avenue to Ninth Avenue; Elm Street from Queen Avenue to 21st Avenue be and the same is hereby adopted.

BE IT RESOLVED, the reports of the City Engineer filed with the City Recorder on the 5th day of April, 1963, concerning the construction of sidewalks Hill Street, Queen Avenue to 28th Avenue; 24th Avenue, Hill Street to Main Street be and the same is hereby adopted.


BE IT RESOLVED, the reports of the City Engineer filed with the City Recorder on the 1st day of April, 1963 concerning a sanitary sewer lateral to serve Lots 41 through 48, Third Addition to Vista Homes and acreage to the East, designated as:

SOUTH RESIDENTIAL SANITARY SEWER LATERAL EXT. NO. 10

be and the same is hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council authorize the Mayor and City Recorder to sign agreements on behalf of the City of Albany for the purpose of obtaining easements to construct the said improvements, direct the City Manager to obtain bids for the construction of said projects as required by law, and authorize the Mayor and City Recorder to make, issue and negotiate General Obligation Improvement Warrants for the performance of said improvements bearing interest at 4% per annum and constituting General Obligations of the City of Albany. The terms and conditions of such warrants shall be as provided by ORS 287.502 to 287.510.
