

RESOLUTION NO. 806

WHEREAS, Pacific Boulevard in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, between Davidson Street and the Freeway Interchange has shown a great increase in cross traffic as well as additional through traffic, and

WHEREAS, a thorough investigation of Pacific Boulevard between Davidson Street and the Freeway Interchange reveals that any speed in excess of 35 miles per hour greatly increases the possibility of automobile collisions, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany that the State Speed Control Board make or cause to be made a survey and traffic investigation with respect to the designated speed for that portion of Pacific Boulevard between Davidson Street and Freeway Interchange, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 483.108 and if said investigation reveals the need therefore, establish a designated speed for this area of 35 miles per hour. Be it further

RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the State Speed Control Board, together with the recommendations of the Albany City Police Department.
