


WHEREAS, the Albany Safety Council has recommended to the City Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, that the following traffic regulations be approved and signs be installed for enforcement of the same:

1. Yield sign at 2nd and Main Street be removed and stop sign be installed regulating South bound traffic.
2. Left turns be prohibited from Pacific Boulevard onto Santiam Road for both East and West bound traffic.
3. Close pedestrian crosswalks on the South and West side of intersection of Santiam Road and Pacific Boulevard and provide a continuous right turn from Pacific onto Santiam Road for East - Southeast bound traffic.
4. Stop sign be installed at 3rd Avenue and Broadalbin Street regulating traffic on Broadalbin Street entering 3rd Avenue.

now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the above traffic regulations are hereby adopted and barricades and appropriate signs be installed.
