

RESOLUTION NO. 1039


WHEREAS, it is necessary that at least two (2) signatures appear on an order for the withdrawal of monies on deposit by the City of Albany and at the present time the signatures are that of the City Manager and the City Recorder, and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 526, City of Albany Resolutions, the Mayor of the City of Albany was authorized to substitute his signature for that of either the City Manager or the City Recorder, this authorization extending to any depository in which the City of Albany has deposited funds, said authorization intended to allow the Mayor of the City of Albany to substitute his signature only when either the City Manager or the City Recorder is absent from the City.

WHEREAS, it is sometimes impossible for the Mayor to execute the order and it would therefore be desirable to designate a second alternate signature in those instances, now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the signature of the Council President, City of Albany Council, is hereby authorized to appear on an order for withdrawing of monies on and after August 31, 1967, in the absence of the Mayor of the City of Albany and in the absence of either the City Recorder or City Manager of the City of Albany.
