

RESOLUTION NO. 1052


WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany has determined that continued operation of the licensed liquor dispensing establishment at 229 West 1st Avenue tends to detract from the commercial and aesthetic potential of that block and the general area of downtown Albany, and

WHEREAS, the best interests of the people of Albany will be served if the negative effect of this establishment is removed and the neighborhood is permitted to develop an atmosphere more conducive to business and shoppers, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that notice be given to the people of the City of Albany, the owners of the property situated at 229 West 1st Avenue, the licensee operating the liquor dispensing establishment at the same address, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission and the members of the City Council of Albany who shall hold office at the time of consideration of an application for renewal, change of ownership or any other liquor license application to be considered for the calendar year 1970, that such application should not be approved by the Albany City Council or the Oregon Liquor Control Commission, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the property owner of such property and the operator of the above described business be advised of the adoption of this resolution and the suggestion that steps be immediately initiated which will lead to the removal of such business to a new location to be approved by the City and the State.
