

RESOLUTION NO. 1503

WHEREAS, the City of Albany is the owner and operator of a sewage system and sewage treatment plant and water system which furnishes the sewer and water service to that property formerly operated by the United States Government and commonly called "Camp Adair properties," and

WHEREAS, the Consumers, namely A. G. Proctor Company, Inc., the Chicano Indian Study Council of Oregon, the State of Oregon, by and through its Oregon State Game Commission, and the Oregon Southwest Washington Lab. Training Trust Fund, have installations on that property formerly part of the Camp Adair complex and these installations require sewer service and water service, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to make additions and repairs to the existing sewer service system and sewage treatment plant and water system in order to provide services requested and the cost of these repairs is to be borne by the users of the sewer and water system, and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to establish charges for the use of the sewer system to be furnished by the City and to further establish water rates for all water furnished to the Consumers, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Albany that it will make all necessary improvements to the existing water and sewer systems on the base, the cost of said improvements to be pre-paid for by the consumers upon billing by the City.

2. All costs of sewage collection and treatment shall be paid by the consumers on the property, prorated based upon the standard City policy.

3. Consumers shall pay for water service the standard rate established which is at the present time \$4.45 per month for the first 7,500 gallons or portion thereof, and 59¢ per 1,000 gallons in excess.

4. All water meters shall be owned by the City.
