

RESOLUTION NO. 2690

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee has proposed that a business registration program be established to create as a public record such information as the business name, address, and emergency contact and to assure that the business complies with land use and other local regulations; and

WHEREAS, it is important that the benefits of a registration program to the community and the business equal or exceed the direct and indirect program costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor appoint with approval of the City Council a Business Registration Task Group consisting of seven residents representing the business community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Group consider issues such as the following:

1. The need public agencies have for information not now readily available and the benefits therefrom.
2. Benefits local businesses would derive from a registration program.
3. Alternative sources of the information.
4. Minimum requirements for a registration program which meet the needs of businesses and local public agencies.
5. Direct and indirect costs to businesses complying with registration requirements.

and report its findings, conclusions, and recommendation to establish or not establish a registration program in Albany to the City Council by October 31, 1987.
