NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council intends to make the improvements and hereby directs the City Engineer to make a survey of the improvements and file a written engineer's report with the City Recorder and further directs the Finance Director to prepare a financial investigation report with such reports to be in compliance with AMC Sections 15.04.020 and 15.04.030.



SUBJECT: Allen Lane Industrial Park LID

SUPRA Corporation is proposing to move forward with development of a site on Allen Lane. Water, sewer and road facilities are required for the development. It has been proposed that these facilities be constructed as part of a local improvement district. The affected property owners have not petitioned for a district, however, the City can initiate the district by stating its intent by resolution.

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution stating its intent to make the public improvements to facilitate the development of the SUPRA site.
