

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR TEA-21 TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF NORTH ALBANY WALKWAY IMPROVEMENTS ALONG US HIGHWAY 20 AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation is administering the distribution of federal highway funds provided by the Transportation Equity Act for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century (TEA-21) for the construction of transportation system enhancement projects; and

WHEREAS, a local match of 20 percent is proposed; and

WHEREAS, receipt of these funds will allow the City to construct pedestrian and bicycle transportation improvements to provide multi-use paths and walkways to connect the north ends of the Ellsworth Street and Lyon Street bridges to the riverfront and to North Albany Road; and

WHEREAS, a commitment to maintain these constructed facilities is required; and

WHEREAS, this application to ODOT for TEA-21 funds will request \$208,000 for completing these improvements and the City of Albany's local match will be approximately \$52,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany approves and endorses the submittal of applications to the Oregon Department of Transportation for TEA-21 funds for the purpose of constructing these transportation enhancement facilities.
