

RESOLUTION NO. 4279

A RESOLUTION EXPANDING THE PERIODS OF SIGNIFICANCE AND CHANGING THE RATINGS' TERMINOLOGY FOR PROPERTIES LISTED IN THE HACKLEMAN, MONTEITH, AND DOWNTOWN COMMERCIAL NATIONAL REGISTER HISTORIC DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Albany's three National Register Historic Districts contain a significant number of historic properties whose preservation and restoration contributes to Albany's unique identity, beauty, and economic vitality; and

WHEREAS, the City recently inventoried the historic resources within these three districts to update the survey information on each building; and

Whereas, in doing the inventory the City determined that the architectural styles and buildings constructed until 1945 are significant historic resources that contribute to the character of the districts; and

WHEREAS, the State Historic Preservation Office is using new ratings terminology and is requesting all localities to convert to the new terminology; and


WHEREAS, the City's Landmarks Advisory Commission and the State Advisory Committee on Historic Preservation have held public hearings on the proposed new ratings terminology; and


WHEREAS, the Landmarks Advisory Committee recommended the proposed changes to the Periods of Significance and the ratings' terminology; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City expand the Periods of Significance to the year 1945 for properties listed in the Hackleman, Downtown Commercial, and Monteith Historic Districts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City adjust the ratings' terminology within these three districts to the terminology recommended by the state and federal preservation authorities, using the terms "Historic Contributing," "Historic Non-Contributing," "Non-Contributing," and "Vacant."
