

RESOLUTION NO. 6173

A RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR THE 2012 COMMUNITY RESILIENCE INNOVATION CHALLENGE THROUGH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) TO PROVIDE 72-HOUR EMERGENCY DISASTER PREPAREDNESS KITS TO VULNERABLE POPULATION CARE PROVIDERS IN ALBANY AND LINN COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency announced the 2012 Community Resilience Innovation Challenge, a new funding opportunity to assist local areas in building and revitalizing community-based partnerships to advance the nation's resilience to disasters; and

WHEREAS, Albany Emergency Management and Linn County Emergency Management have identified a need to equip daycare, adult foster care, and residential care facilities in Albany and throughout Linn County with 72-hour emergency disaster preparedness kits; and

WHEREAS, emergency disaster preparedness kits are directly related to resilience to disasters as described in the 2012 Community Resilience Innovation Challenge; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 Community Resilience Innovation Challenge requires no matching funds; and


WHEREAS, the deadline to apply for the 2012 Community Resilience Innovation Challenge is October 26, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Albany City Council authorizes the Fire Department to apply for up to \$35,000 from the 2012 Community Resilience Innovation Challenge to provide 72-hour emergency disaster preparedness kits to vulnerable population care providers in Albany and Linn County.
