

RESOLUTION NO. 7095

A RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT NOT TO EXCEED \$232,789 ON BEHALF OF CITY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR FIRE STATION ACCESS SYSTEM UPGRADES AND A POLICE DEPARTMENT SURVEILLANCE TRAILER.

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security, through Oregon Emergency Management, makes funds available to improve community preparedness and resilience; and

WHEREAS, the need for security cameras and access card readers at the three oldest fire stations has been identified; and


WHEREAS, the need for a surveillance trailer for use at community events to increase safety and awareness has been identified; and

WHEREAS, the needs identified support the purpose of the grant, and

WHEREAS, the application deadline is April 3, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that the City Emergency Manager is approved to apply for the FY 22 Department of Homeland Security Grant in an amount not to exceed \$232,789 for fire station security upgrades and a surveillance trailer.
